Ordinary membership: < 200 Users \$825 (inc. GST) or > 200 Users \$1,650 (inc. GST)

The primary business of the organisation must not be that of a consultant organisation which provides, as part of its core business, professional advice on the use of SAP products.

Consultant membership: \$1,650 (inc. GST)

Open to any organisation, which in the opinion of the Committee is associated with the use of SAP products in a professional capacity. The organisation may or may not be a user of SAP solutions.

- Up to 2 attendees from the membership organisation to any SAUG Plenary at no charge **(please note: Consultant members are limited to 2 attendees maximum at Plenaries unless exhibiting or speaking)**
- Attendance at SAUG Summits at discounted membership rates

- Unlimited user accounts on the SAUG website
- Access to media / presentations from past Plenaries
- Research reports from leading Universities and other established sources

Open to persons who in the opinion of the Committee are neither a professional (licensed) user of SAP products nor a “Professional Adviser” of SAP products or services. Membership covers one individual.
